ÅLAND XXXV ORGAN FESTIVAL 21–27.6.2009






The oldest annual music event of Åland is arranged for the 35th time. Musicians from Åland, Sweden, Norway, the USA, Poland, Lithuania, Liechtenstein and Germany will perform in concerts held in nine churches all around Åland. This year's festival commemorates the work of two great composers, Georg Friedrich Händel and Felix Mendelssohn, both being celebrated with a jubilee year in 2009.

For the first time, the festival also proudly presents an African organist Patrick Kabanda. Other famous organists are Thomas Nipp, Dome Organist in Vaduz in Liechtenstein, Leopoldas Digrys from Lithuania, and Wolfram Syré from Norway. The festival also offers concerts by Åland singers Björn Blomqvist, Frida Jansson and Frida Österberg. We will also have the pleasure to listen to the world-famous trumpet player Roman Gryn and to one of the best string quartets of Europe, Via Regale from Helsinki.

The varied concert programme includes different themes and concerts for the young audience.
